- 1. The entire quantity of Calendar should be printed and supplied on or before 30th November 2025 itself in all 60 distribution centers all over Kerala through a separate vehicle by the successful printer/ vendor /bidder as per our specification.
- 2. The entire designing cost of calendar including DTP charges should be borne by the successful bidder. The Company will arrange a designer for designing the calendar. The cost for designing will be paid by the company and the same will be deducted from the final bill of the vendor
- 3. Due to time constraints and as we need to distribute calendars to our customers from branches (683 Nos all over Kerala) from 1st December 2025 onwards itself, so the entire supply must be completed on or before 30th November 2025 itself. Hence, time is the essence of this e-tender.
- 4. There are about 60 distribution centers for supply across Kerala. The entire supply should be completed on or before 30th November 2025 itself. Calendars supplied after the above stated date may be rejected by the company.

- 2. Tender forms can be obtained from web site www.etenders.kerala.gov.in. The cost of tender forms once paid will not be refunded. Further clarification/corrigendum in this regard, if any, will be put up only on the above site. Bidders should regularly visit the above web site to keep themselves updated.
- 3. The eligible bidders must have GST registration and the rates quoted must be inclusive of all taxes, duties and cesses prevailing and likely to be levied in future by the State Govt. / Central Govt

- 9. - 21. If the supply is delayed beyond the period specified above, the Company will have the liberty to either terminate the contract at the cost and risk of the contractor.

General Tender Terms & Conditions for e-Procurement

This tender is an e-Tender and is being published online for the supply of **CALENDAR FOR THE YEAR 2026** (60 distribution centers all over Kerala). The tender is invited in **01** cover system from the registered and eligible firms through e-procurement portal of Government of Kerala (https://www.etenders.kerala.gov.in). Prospective bidders willing to participate in this tender shall necessarily register themselves with above mentioned e-procurement portal.

The tender timeline is available in the critical date section of this tender published in www.etenders.kerala.gov.in.

A). Online Bidder registration process:

Bidders should have a Class II or above Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) to be procured from any Registration Authorities (RA) under the Certifying Agency of India. Details of RAs will be available on www.cca.gov.in. Once, the DSC is obtained, bidders have to register on www.etenders.kerala.gov.in website for participating in this tender. Website registration is a one-time process without any registration fees. However, bidders have to procure DSC at their own cost.

B). Online Tender Process:

The tender process shall consist of the following stages:

- iii. **Publishing of Corrigendum**: All corrigenda shall be published on www.etenders.kerala.gov.in and shall not be available elsewhere.
